EBRP Traffic Ordinances

Sec. 11:415 Stopping, Standing or parking prohibited; general rules.

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, or permit a vehicle registered in his name to be stopped, standing or parkedin any of the following places:

- (1) In front of or blocking a public or private driveway;
- (6) Within twenty-five (25) feet of a ...curbline at an intersection;
- (7) Within thirty (30) feet upon the approach to any ..., stop signs... located at the side of a roadway;
- (15) On the driver's left-hand side of any two-way street or highway;
- (20) Upon the traveled portion of any roadway except to yield to other traffic...;
- (21) On the grass in a yard between the residence and the street of any lot in the A1, A2, A2.5, A3, or A4 districts and in recognized subdivisions in the rural district.

Sec. 11:416 Parking on neutral ground, parks, rights-of-way, sidewalks and other public and privates places prohibited.

(a) No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle or permit a vehicle registered in his name to be stopped, standing or parked ... at any of the following places:

- (1) Upon a neutral ground, right-of-way, sidewalk, strip of land between a property line and street, curb or other public way.

Sec. 11:423 Time limitation on parking on any street.

No person shall permit his vehicle, either as an operator or registered owner, to remain parked on any street for a period of time longer than nine (9) hours of any twenty-four (24) hour period beginning at 6:00 am of one day to 6:00 am of the next day...
